Greenfield-Central High School Auditorium

All students must be in cafeteria/dressing areas at least 45 minutes before show time. We will check or apply make-up, help with costumes and warm-up. Doors to auditorium will open 45 minutes before show time. Only exceptions are **Jumping Jacks & Tiny Tots**. (Please bring them to cafeteria, in costume, 30 minutes before show.) "Break a Leg" circle is 6:40 pm!

1. **NO STUDENTS** (except JJ & TT) **PERMITTED IN THE AUDIENCE AT ANY TIME!!!** JJ & Tiny Tots will go to their parents in the audience after they dance. They may rejoin us on stage for the finale, if they wish. All others must stay in cafeteria and dressing rooms until finale.
2. **ALL** students **MUST** stay for the *Finale*. They will receive a "memento" afterward. Students should wear **SHOWSHIRT** and black legs **OR** a costume. (Please do not ask that your child be released before the show is over.) The show is about 2 1/2 hours.
3. **Security measures** will be in place at the dressing area entrance. **ONE** parent will be permitted to this area with each dancer. They will receive a security bracelet at the door. No others permitted.
4. **Costume Changes:** Parent should come backstage to help with any costume changes. Check the **SHOW ORDER**, not the Dress Rehearsal order, to know if you have a "fast change". *Please let us know and we will make arrangements for fast changes!!*
5. **CHAPERONES**: Designated chaperones will be assigned to each class under 4th grade. They will help with activities, refreshments, costumes and make-up. Please apply in the office.

VIDEO CAMERAS – NO TABLETS. battery powered, do not obstruct other's view. We will have a professional videographer capturing the show with edited, wide screen, low light cameras.

NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY - For the safety of the dancers as well as courtesy to the rest of the audience, please do NOT use *flash* cameras! This will be enforced.

In Dealing With Over 300 children, we must have some rules to stay organized and keep the children safe. If you have a problem or question, please see one of the workers who are helping in the cafeteria or at the doors. Please be *courteous* to these people, as they have kindly volunteered their help to make this show possible. Thank you so much for your cooperation.
